1) Call to Order: President Deschane called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Pres. Deschane declared a quorum present for the meeting.

- **3) Adoption of Agenda:** Motion by Trustee Franzen, seconded by Trustee Swanson, that the agenda be adopted as presented. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.
- **Minutes Approval:** Motion by Trustee Franzen, seconded by Trustee Swanson, that the minutes of the regular meeting of June 19th be approved as presented. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.
- 5) **Financial Report:** Motion by Trustee Franzen, seconded by Trustee Swanson, that the financial report for the month of June be approved as presented. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.
- **6**) **General Fund Vouchers:** Motion by Trustee Franzen, seconded by Trustee Swanson, to approve payment of general fund vouchers numbered 2832 through 2835, 4104, 6085, 7007, 27263 through 27349, and V6949 through V6974. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.

Motion by Trustee Franzen, seconded by Trustee Swanson, to approve payment from the general fund to Cardmember Services for supplies and expenses for various departments in the amount of \$1,668.63. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.

- **6a)** Water Fund: Motion by Trustee Grandaw, seconded by Trustee Franzen, to approve payment of water fund vouchers numbered 4180 through 4185. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.
- **6b) Sewer Fund:** Motion by Trustee Grandaw, seconded by Trustee Franzen, to approve payment of sewer fund vouchers numbered 5356 through 5365. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.

Motion by Trustee Grandaw, seconded by Trustee Franzen, to approve payment from the sewer fund to Mulcahy Shaw Water for repairs to the WWTF sampler system in the amount of \$2,440.00, which will be partially reimbursed by Selective Insurance. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.

- **6c) Other Fund Vouchers:** Motion by Trustee Swanson, seconded by Trustee Patefield, to approve payment of TIF fund vouchers numbered 5044 through 5045. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.
- 7) Committee & Attorney Reports: Committee reports were distributed prior to the meeting. Atty. Boren reported the first trial at the Northeast Wisconsin Multi-Jurisdictional Court in Coleman went well.

- 8) **Compost Site Clean-up:** (Public Works) Motion by Trustee Patefield, seconded by Trustee Dorschner, to approve contracting with MJB Industries for cleaning up the compost site at a cost not to exceed \$8,000.00, to be reimbursed by the Northwoods Recycling Coalition. Discussion: Trustee Patefield reported that payment has been received from the coalition, however the site has never been registered through the WDNR. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.
- 9) **Compost Site Motion Sensor Cameras:** (Public Works) Motion by Trustee Patefield, seconded by Trustee Dorschner, to approve the purchase of two motion sensor cameras for the compost site at a cost not to exceed \$300.00. Discussion: Pres. Deschane noted that one camera would be placed inside the site and one outside the gate. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.
- 10) Village Hall Boiler Repair: (Public Works) Motion by Trustee Patefield, seconded by Trustee Dorschner, to accept the proposal from Dama Plumbing & Heating to repair two of the Village Hall boilers for a total cost of \$888.20. Discussion: Trustee Swanson stated the system at the Fire Station is not heating properly. Trustee Patefield said he would put this on the next Public Works agenda. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.
- 11) Village Hall Cross Connection Device: Bypassed per Glen Franzen.
- 12) **2012 F550 Truck Wing Sandblasting & Painting:** (Public Works) Motion by Trustee Patefield, seconded by Trustee Dorschner, to accept the proposal from Starzer Repair for sandblasting and painting the 2012 F550 truck wing at a cost not to exceed \$650.00. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.
- 13) **Homecoming Parade Street Use Permit:** (Public Safety) Motion by Trustee Dorschner, seconded by Trustee Patefield, to approve street use permit for the 2018 homecoming parade for Friday, September 28 beginning at 2:20pm. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.
- 14) **ATV/UTV Route Signs & Posts:** (Parks & Recreation) Motion by Trustee Swanson, seconded by Trustee Franzen, to approve the purchase of ATV/UTV route signs and posts from Rent-A-Flash at a cost not to exceed \$3,000.00. Discussion: It was noted that Gateway will be holding a fundraiser to help pay for the signs. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.
- 15) **Triangle Park Water Tank:** (Parks & Recreation) Motion by Trustee Swanson, seconded by Trustee Franzen, to approve payment to Richlen Excavating for a water tank at Triangle Park in an amount not to exceed \$750.00. Discussion: Pres. Deschane reported that this tank replaces the leaking concrete tank, which had been costing the Village over 10,000 gallons of water each month. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.
- 16) **CBA Art in the Park Picnic Beer & Wine License:** (Finance) Motion by Trustee Franzen, seconded by Trustee Swanson, to grant a temporary Class B beer and wine license to the Crivitz Business Association, Jolene Huc, Manager, for Art in the Park at the Shaffer Pavilion on Saturday, August 11, 2018, from 1:00 to 4:00pm, provided wristbands are issued and grounds monitored to prevent underage drinking. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.
- 17) **Combine Committees:** (Finance) Motion by Trustee Franzen, seconded by Trustee Patefield, to combine the Public Works & Utilities Committees into one committee and to create a Personnel Committee, with duties to be assigned per the attached worksheet. Discussion: Pres. Deschane noted this change would be effective 04/16/19. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.
- 18) **Operators Licenses:** (Finance) Motion by Trustee Franzen, seconded by Trustee Swanson, to grant operators licenses for the term of 7/17/18 through 6/30/20 to Kersten Gibson, who has received a satisfactory records check. Vote: Ayes: 5. Motion carried.
